Marathon MaRS is an international sports charity campaign in the field of Multiple sclerosis, organized by Endowment Fund IMPULS (a non-governmental, non-profit foundation), in which participate MS patients, healthcare professionals, doctors and the general public.

Guideline for Hosts and Partners

In order to maintain the visual unity and the idea of the sports charity Marathon MaRS all organizers are asked to observe the following conditions:

-  All printed and on-line materials related to the Marathon MaRS indicate official title „Marathon MaRS“, and the logo.
-  All activities related to the Marathon must fulfill its main objective (promoting regular exercise and rehabilitation – sports campaign in favor of MS patients).
-  All exercises and activities must be appropriate for people with MS and must be manned by qualified supervision (trainers, physiotherapists).
-  The Event can be supported by voluntary admission of participants and partners. Proceeds are aimed to support the training and rehabilitation for MS patients.
-  The Project has a charitable nature, therefore each event organizer is asked for a license fee, which is dedicated to IMPULS Foundation in order to support exercise activities of Czech MS patients.
-  All organizers are asked to connect with the Prague session during the Marathon (via Skype, Hangouts, facebook etc.) in order to keep in touch and maintain the main idea of the Event “Together against MS”.
